

LAWS OF NEW YORK, 2007

CHAPTER 276

AN ACT to amend chapter 672 of the laws of 1993, amending the public authorities law relating to the construction and financing of facilities for certain public libraries, in relation to including Smithtown Special Library District within the provisions of such chapter

Became a law July 18, 2007, with the approval of the Governor.  
Passed by a majority vote, three-fifths being present.

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 5 of chapter 672 of the laws of 1993, amending the public authorities law relating to the construction and financing of facilities for certain public libraries, as separately amended by chapters 488 and 504 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as follows:

§ 5. The following libraries shall be eligible public libraries for purposes of title 4 of article 8 of the public authorities law:

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
